Good bite going on right now for Salmon and Northern Pike on Lake Oahe in the Pierre, South Dakota area.&nbsp; Salmon are up shallow right now, 40 foot or less and being taken on plugs and spoons on the very lower end of Lake Oahe near Oahe Dam.&nbsp;Trophy Northern Pike are moving into the back bays of Lake Oahe preparing to spawn.&nbsp; Fish with frozen Smelt&nbsp; on Quick strike rigs In the very back bays of Lake Oahe.&nbsp; True Trophy bite, nothing real fast but the fish run 15 to 30 pounds.&nbsp; For a up to date fishing report see [www.dakotawalleye.com](http://www.dakotawalleye.com).&nbsp;
