We had to reposition the boat and could not get them going again. We then made a couple of moves and picked up a few fish at each. One more move a little closer in and it was on. They put good Trout in the boat till we ran out of bait. By this time it was hot and time to call it a day, and a good one it was. The guys had a blast putting 65 Trout, 1 Red, and 7 Sheepshead on ice. The Trout are on and the fishing in Shell Beach is outstanding.
